



## **INSTALLATION TIPS**

## For the NEW 21027904 and 21027905

- 1. The 10 year litium battery MUST BE activated first before connecting to the 120V
- 2. We have had a few customers feedback advising that when they install one of the new 21027904 or 21027905 smoke alarm or combo alarm, the unit will chirp and say "replace alarm".

Inside the alarm box, there is our "Quick set up Guide" one page

The one page has the activation tool attached to the sheet. The installer should use this activation tool or the mounting plate (bracket) to activate the alarm **prior** to connecting it to 120v.

If the installer connects into the 120v without activating the battery, the unit will chirp every 60 seconds or so and it will have the audible "replace alarm".

To stop this audible "replace alarm", please use the Kidde activation tool to activate the battery.
